

CONSENT AND RELEASE FORM:

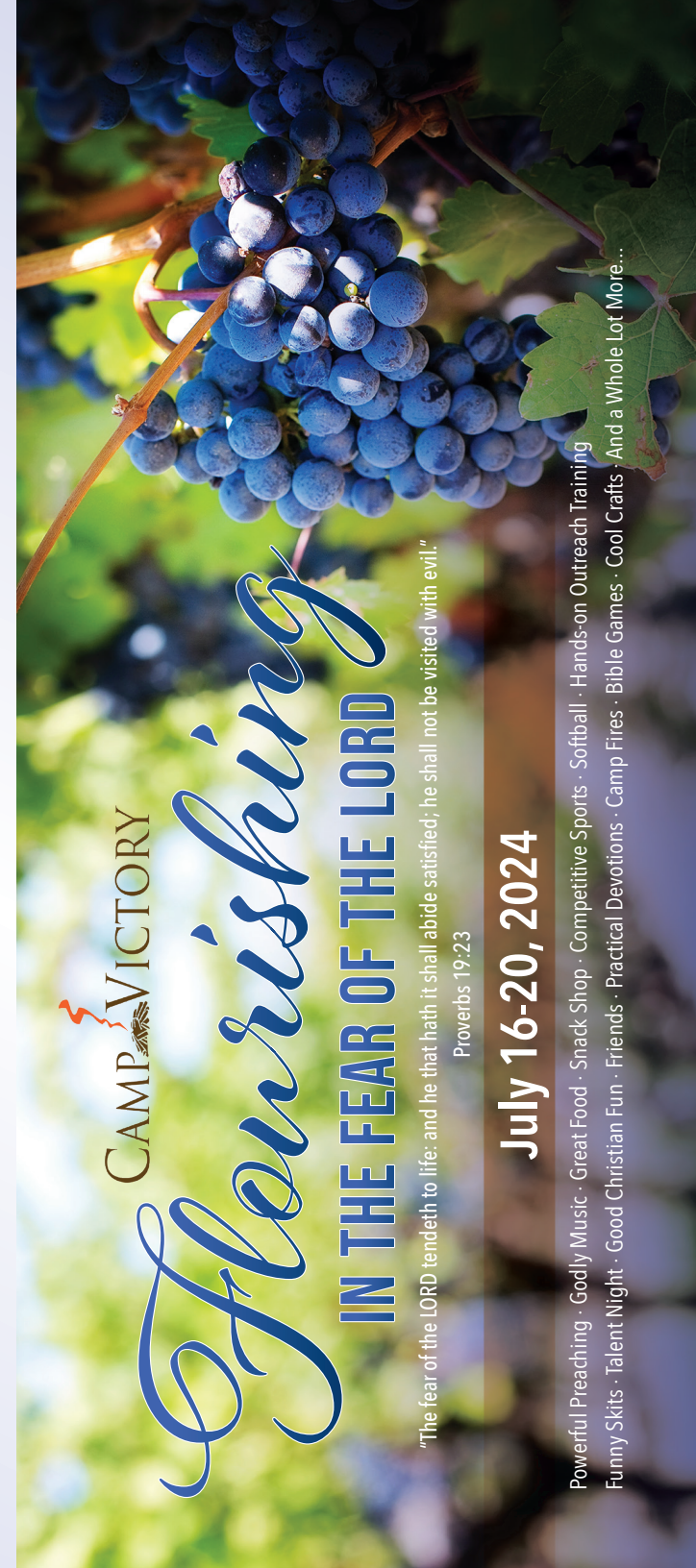

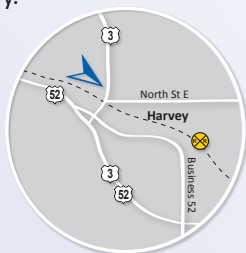


SPECIAL GUESTS:
